Re: Appeals of Egress Windows (March 6, 2012 Legislative Hearing)

Dear Mr. Swanson:

This is to confirm that Marcia Moermond, Legislative Hearing Officer, has reviewed the above-referenced matters and recommended the following to the City Council:

<u>1664 Chambers Street</u> - grant a 3-inch variance on the openable height of the egress window in the southeast bedroom;

<u>1222 Desoto Street</u> - grant a 1-inch variance on the openable width of the egress windows in the southeast and northeast bedrooms <u>and grant a 5-inch variance on the openable height of</u> the egress window in the southwest bedroom:

<u>842 Geranium Avenue East</u> - grant a 2-inch variance on the openable height of the egress window in the north bedroom;

<u>789 Hyacinth Avenue East</u> - grant a 5-inch variance on the openable height of the egress windows in the north and south bedrooms;

876 Sherwood Avenue - grant a 4.5-inch variance on the openable height of the egress window in the 2nd floor bedroom; and

<u>1676 Westminster Street</u> - grant a 1-inch variance on the openable height of the egress window in the first floor, northeast bedroom and grant a 6-inch variance on the openable height of the egress window in the 2nd floor bedroom.

The City Council Public Hearing is scheduled for Wednesday, April 4, 2012 at 5:30 p.m. in Rooms 40A & B; however, you don't need to attend since the appeal has been granted.
