- 2. Basement Stairway SPLC 34.10 (3), 34.33(2) Provide an approved handrail. The top of the handrail must be between 34 and 38 inches above the treads and run the entire length of the stair.
- 3. Basement Throughout MSFC 605.4 Discontinue use of all multi-plug adapters.

4. Egress Window - MSFC1026.1 - Provide and maintain an approved escape window from each sleeping room. The minimum size must be 5 square feet of glazed area with a minimum of 24 inches of openable height and 20 inches of openable width. With a finished sill height not more than 48 inches. - 5. Exterior West Eave SPLC 34.08 (5), 34.31 (3) Repair, replace and maintain all exterior surfaces free from holes and deterioration. Provide and maintain exterior unprotected surfaces painted or protected from the elements.-Replace the missing fascia.
- 6. Main Floor Bathroom UMC 504.6 Provide, repair or replace the dryer exhaust duct. Exhaust ducts for domestic clothes dryers shall be constructed of metal and shall have a smooth interior finish. The exhaust duct shall be a minimum nominal size of four inches (102 mm) in diameter.-Remove the unapproved duct tape from the dryer exhaust duct and replace with approved material.
- 7. Main Floor Bathroom SPC 4715.0400 Provide approved plumbing materials for water, waste, and vent.-Remove the unapproved flexible plumbing and replace with approved material.
- 8. Main Floor South Entry Door SPLC 34.09 (3) i Repair and maintain an approved one-inch throw single cylinder deadbolt lock.
- 9. Upper Floor Bedroom SPLC 34.13 (1) Provide and maintain all habitable areas with a ceiling height of 7 feet over 1/2 the floor area.

The upper floor room that is being used as a sleeping room has sloped walls/ceiling. The specifics are as follows:

Room Dimension: 18.5 feet wide x 29.5 feet long = 445.75 sf

Area above 5 feet: 10 feet wide x 20 feet long = 200 sf Area of ceiling at 7 feet: 4 feet wide x 15 feet long = 60 sf

Immediately remove the bed and discontinue using this room for habitability. This room is approved as storage only.

- 10. Upper Floor Bedroom MN State Statute 299F.50 Immediately provide and maintain an approved Carbon Monoxide Alarm in a location within ten (10) feet of each sleeping area. Installation shall be in accordance with manufacturers instructions.
- 11. SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3) Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office.

12. SPLC 39.02(c) - Complete and sign the smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.
