## Fiscal Analysis

 Craig Johnson, Sr. was employed, and is still employed by the Department of Public Works when he, and another City employee, were struck by an underinsured motorist on April 26th, 2011. Mr. Johnson sustained multiple injuries including an amputation of the left arm at the elbow which has required the City to purchase a prosthetic device. In addition Mr. Johnson will be undergoing a right knee replacement and has already undergone multiple leg operations. The responsible party's insurance bodily injury limits were \$100,000, which they have tendered. The City is self-insured for all vehicle insurance and we have agreed to settle with Mr. Johnson, through his attorney, for our limits of Underinsured motorist limits of \$25,000 and our No-Fault insurance limits of \$20,000 for replacement services for which Mr. Johnson is also legally entitled to receive, in addition to his workers compensation benefits. These are one time lump sum payments which relieve the City of all future obligations.
