Revocation of Fire Certificate of Occupancy and Order to Vacate

RE: 845 IGLEHART AVE

Dear Property Representative:

Your building was inspected on April 12, 2012, for the renewal of the Certificate of Occupancy. Since you have failed to comply with the applicable requirements, it has become necessary to revoke the Certificate of Occupancy in accordance with Section 40.06 of the Saint Paul Legislative Code.

A reinspection will be made on April 30, 2012 at 2:00 PM or the property vacated.

The Saint Paul Legislative Code further provides that no building shall be occupied without a Certificate of Occupancy. Failure to immediately complete the following deficiency list or the building vacated may result in a criminal citation.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. Basement Stairwell MSFC 605.1 Repair or replace damaged electrical fixtures. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-9090. -Repair non-working light fixture.
- 2. Basement MFGC 503 Provide, repair or replace the fuel equipment vent to develop a positive flow adequate to convey all products of combustion to the outside. This work will require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-8989. The furnace vent is improperly installed.-Contact a licensed contractor to properly install vent under permit.
- 3. Basement MSFC 605.6 Provide all electrical splices within junction boxes.
- 4. Basement MSFC 605.6 Provide electrical cover plates to all outlets, switches and junction boxes where missing.

- 5. Basement - SPLC 34.11 (4), 34.34 (1), MPC 4515, MPC 326 - Connect the sewer piping in accordance with the plumbing code. This work will require a permit. Contact DSI at 651-266-8989. The drain piping for the laundry does not meet code.-Contact a licensed plumber to properly install the laundry drain to code. Obtain approval under permit.
- 6. Basement - NEC 300-4 - Provide for conductors to be adequately protected from physical damage.
- 7. Basement - NEC 110-12 - Provide for the electrical equipment to be installed in a neat and worker like manner.
- 8. Basement - SPLC 34.10 - Repair and maintain the walls in an approved manner. The basement has been partially finished and remodeled without permit. This work will require a building permit. Contact DSI at 651-266-8989.-Contact a licensed contractor to obtain approval under permit for renovation.
- 9. Basement - MFGC 304 - Provide approved combustion make up air in compliance with the mechanical code. This work will require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-9090.
- 10. Basement - UMC 504.6 - Provide, repair or replace the dryer exhaust duct. Exhaust ducts for domestic clothes dryers shall be constructed of metal and shall have a smooth interior finish. The exhaust duct shall be a minimum nominal size of four inches (102 mm) in diameter. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-8989. -Remove the screws from the dryer vent and replace with an approved product.
- 11. Interior - Throughout - SPLC 34.14 (2), 34.34 (5) - Provide an approved electrical service adequate to meet the buildings needs. This work will require a permit(s); call DSI at (651) 266-9090. Romex has been installed improperly throughout the basement including dates 8/13/10 and 9/8/10. The upper unit has recently had electrical baseboard heat added.-Contact a licensed electrician to properly install all recently modified wiring and fixtures to code and under permit.
- Lower Unit North Bedroom SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) Provide or repair and 12. maintain the window screen.
- 13. Lower Unit - South Bedroom - MSFC 605.4 - Discontinue use of all multi-plug adapters.
- Lower Unit Sun Room MSFC 605.1 Repair or replace damaged electrical fixtures. 14. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-9090. -Repair non-grounded three prong outlet.

 - -Repair loose outlet.
- SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3) Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor 15. which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit an approved completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office.
- 16. SPLC 39.02(c) - Complete and sign the smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.

You have the right to appeal these orders to the Legislative Hearing Officer.
