NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Lisa Clark, CEO Mojo Monkey 1169 - 7th Street West St. Paul, MN 55102

All licenses held by The Depot Express, LLC d/b/a Mojo Monkey for the premises located at 1169-7th Street West

in Saint Paul

Dear Ms. Clark:

The Department of Safety and Inspections (DSI) will recommend adverse action against all licenses held by The Depot Express, LLC d/b/a Mojo Monkey for the premises located at 1169-7th Street West in Saint Paul. The basis for the recommendation is as follows:

On January 17, 2012, the Department of Safety and Inspections (DSI) - Environmental Health Division conducted an inspection of your establishment and cited you for one (1) CRITICAL-MAJOR Environmental Health Code violation: Cold food not maintained at 41 degrees Fahrenheit or less (1 ½ gallons of milk 62.1°F, 9 quarts of heavy whipping cream 57.3°F - 66.3°F, 3 quarts of ½ & ½ 61°F to 62°F, 5 pounds of sour cream 56.2°F, 2-24 oz. sour cream at 54.7°F-60.3°F and eggs at 60.6°F.) and one (1) CRITICAL-MINOR Environmental Health Code violation: Bulk food in open containers (open bags of flour and other baking ingredients).

On January 18, 2012, the inspector returned with the <u>Notice of New Critical Violations</u> report listing these violations and stating that they needed to be corrected. You were then informed that a reinspection would take place on or after February 16, 2012.

On January 18, 2012, you were also cited for a second (2nd) CRITICAL-MAJOR Environmental Health Code violation: Cold food not maintained at 41 degrees Fahrenheit or less (cream filled donuts are not shelf stable and not kept under refrigeration).

On January 19, 2012, you were sent a second (2nd) <u>Notice of New Critical Violations</u> listing this new violation and stating that it needed to be corrected. You were then informed that a re-inspection would take place on or after February 17, 2012.

On February 21, 2012, the Environmental Health Division of DSI conducted a re-inspection of your establishment and cited you for one (1) of the same CRITICAL—MAJOR Environmental Health Code violation that had not been corrected by the February 16, 2012 deadline: Cold food not maintained at 41 degrees Fahrenheit or less (temperature of a cracked egg in the cooler was 46°F).

This is a violation of Minnesota Administrative Rules part 4626.0395: "Immediately, maintain all cold readily perishable food at 41 degrees Fahrenheit or less."

As a result, per Saint Paul Legislative Code §310.05 (m) (9), the licensing office will recommend a \$175.00 matrix penalty and suspension of your licenses until the violation is corrected.

At this time, you have three options on how to proceed:

- 1. If you wish to admit to the violation and you do not contest the penalty you need to do two (2) things:
 - 1) Pay the \$175.00 matrix penalty. You can send the payment to the Department of Safety and Inspections (DSI) located at 375 Jackson Street, Ste. 220, St. Paul, Minnesota 55101-1806 no later than Friday, April 6, 2012. A self-addressed envelope is enclosed for your convenience.
 - 2) You also need to contact Diane Olson, R.S. Environmental Health Specialist at (651) 266-9138 by Friday, April 6, 2012, to schedule a re-inspection in order to verify that the violation has been corrected. Payment of the \$175.00 matrix penalty and correction of the violation will be considered a waiver of the hearing to which you are entitled.
- 2. If you wish to admit the facts but you contest the penalty, you may have a public hearing before the Saint Paul City Council. You will need to send me a letter with a statement admitting to the facts and requesting a public hearing. I will need to receive your letter by Friday, April 6, 2012. The matter will then be scheduled before the City Council for a public hearing to determine whether to impose the \$175.00 matrix penalty and license suspensions. You will have an opportunity to appear before the Council and make a statement on your own behalf.
- 3. If you dispute the facts outlined above, you may request a hearing before an Administrative Law Judge (ALJ). You will need to send me a letter disputing the facts and requesting an administrative hearing by Friday, April 6, 2012. At that hearing both you and the City will appear and present witnesses, evidence and cross-examine each other's witnesses. After receipt of the ALJ's report (usually within 30 days), a public hearing will need to be scheduled. At that time, the City Council will decide whether to adopt, modify or reject the ALJ's report and recommendation.

If you have not contacted me or the Environmental Health Specialist by Friday, April 6, 2012, I will assume that you are not contesting the imposition of the \$175.00 matrix penalty and license suspensions. In that case, the matter will be placed on the City Council Consent Agenda for approval of the recommended penalty.
