## **Saint Paul Community Food Gardens**

*Includes gardens on both public and private properties* 

43 food production gardens

15 youth-focused (also food production-Community Design Center plots, Youth Farm plots, schools)

## 58 total food gardens

Smallest = 0.05 acre (most youth gardens are about this size)

Largest = 3 acres (Maryland property—this is much larger than the average garden)

Average garden size = 0.20 acre (food production gardens, not including Maryland)

$$43 \times .2 = 8.6$$
  
 $15 \times 0.05 = 0.75$   
 $8.6 + 0.75 = 9.35$ 

- ~9.5 acres in food production gardens (youth gardens included).
- **12.5** acres total including the Maryland property.

Estimate of 1798 gardeners involved in these gardens (about 31 people per garden).

Minneapolis has about 100 food production gardens and 26 youth gardens, for a total of 126 food gardens.
