To the Members of the Saint Paul City Council:

Hamline Midway Coalition **supports** the recommended zoning amendments to the City's use definitions and off-street parking requirements for establishments serving wind, beer, or liquor that would:

- Define a "restaurant" as an establishment serving food, with or without wine, beer, or liquor service that closes by midnight.
- Adopt an off-street parking requirement for restaurants of 1 space per 400 sq. ft. of space.

This minor change in the zoning code will be highly beneficial to new restaurants that might wish to locate in the Hamline Midway area, as well as existing restaurants that might wish to add wine, beer, and/or liquor service.
