Your building was inspected on March 8, 2012 for the renewal of your Fire Certificate of Occupancy. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected prior to the re-inspection date. A re-inspection will be made on April 9, 2012 at 10:00 A.M..

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional re-inspection fees.

YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR NOTIFYING TENANTS IF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING LIST OF DEFICIENCIES ARE THEIR RESPONSIBILITY.

#### **DEFICIENCY LIST**

- 1. 904 MSFC 605.5 Discontinue use of extension cords used in lieu of permanent wiring.
- 2. 904 NEC 410-8 (b) (1) Provide for the incandescent fixtures in closets to have a completely enclosed lamp.
- 3. 904 MSFC 605.1- All light fixtures shall be maintained with protective globes if originally equipped.
- 4. 904 MSFC 1003.3.1.8 Remove unapproved locks from the unit doors. The door must be openable from the inside without the use of keys or special knowledge or effort.-front entry door
- 5. 908 SPLC 34.08 (7) All parking spaces shall be paved with asphalt, concrete, or durable dustless surfacing. Before any existing spaces may be paved, site plan approval must be obtained as specified in the St. Paul Zoning Code. Contact DSI Zoning at 651- 266-9090.

- 6. 904 MSFC 605.6 Provide all openings in junction boxes to be sealed.
- 7. 904 MSFC1026.1 Provide and maintain an approved escape window from each sleeping room. The minimum size must be 5 square feet of glazed area with a minimum of 24 inches of openable height and 20 inches of openable width. With a finished sill height not more than 48 inches. This work may require permit(s). Call DSI at (651)- 266-9090. Refer to the Escape Windows for Residential Occupancies handout for more information.-Double hung windows. 19inches openable height. Openable width is 26inches. Sill 26inches. Glazed 48inches in height by 23inches in width.
- 8. 906 MSFC 605.5 Discontinue use of extension cords used in lieu of permanent wiring.
- 9. 906 NEC 440.13 For cord-connected equipment such as room air conditioners, household refrigerators and freezers, drinking water coolers, and beverage dispensers, a separable connector or an attachment plug and receptacle shall be permitted to serve as the disconnecting means. The appliance must plug directly into a permanent outlet.- Kitchen
- 10. 906 SPLC 34.10 (4), 34.33 (3) Provide a bathroom floor impervious to water. After securing toilet to floor caulk the base.
- 11. 906 MSFC 703 Provide and maintain fire rated wall construction with approved materials and methods. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-9090. The minimum rating must be:-Bedroom S.W.Side
- 12. 906 SPLC 34.10 (7), 34.33 (6) Repair or replace and maintain the woodwork in an approved manner.-Interior wood doors
- 13. 906 SPLC 34.11, SBC 2902.1, SPLC 34.17, MPC 415.0220 Repair or replace and maintain the plumbing fixture to an operational condition.-Repair or replace and maintain an approved private toilet. Secure toilet to floor.
- 14. 906 SPLC 34.13 (3), SPLC 34.17 (2) Reduce and maintain the number of occupants in the sleeping rooms to: 2-Bedroom S.W. Side
- 15. Access to 908 SPLC 34.19 Provide access to the inspector to all areas of the building.
- 16. Basement MSFC 605.1 Remove unapproved exposed wiring and install in accordance with the electrical code. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-9090.
- 17. Basement MSFC 703 Provide and maintain fire rated wall construction with approved materials and methods. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-9090. The minimum rating must be: 1! HOUR
- 18. Basement MSFC 703 Provide and maintain fire rated floor and/or ceiling construction with approved materials and methods. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-9090. The minimum rating must be:1 HOUR
- 19. Basement SPLC 34.10 (1) Abate and maintain the basement reasonably free from dampness and free of mold and mildew.
- 20. Upstairs Unit MSFC 605.6 Provide all openings in junction boxes to be sealed.

- 21. Upstairs Unit SPLC 34.10 (4), 34.33 (3) Provide a bathroom floor impervious to water. After securing toilet to floor caulk the base.
- 22. Upstairs Unit SPLC 34.11, SBC 2902.1, SPLC 34.17, MPC 415.0220 Repair or replace and maintain the plumbing fixture to an operational condition.-Repair or replace and maintain an approved private toilet. Secure toilet to floor
- 23. Upstairs Unit SPLC 34.09 (3) i Provide and maintain an approved one-inch throw single cylinder deadbolt lock.
- 24. SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3) Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office.
- 25. SPLC 39.02(c) Complete and sign the smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.
- 26. SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) Provide or repair and maintain the window screens.
