Dear Property Representative:

Your building was inspected on April 11, 2012 for the renewal of your Fire Certificate of Occupancy. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected prior to the re-inspection date. A reinspection will be made on May 11, 2012 at 10:00 am.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR NOTIFYING TENANTS IF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING LIST OF DEFICIENCIES ARE THEIR RESPONSIBILITY.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. 1st Floor Kitchen Rear Entry SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) Repair and maintain the door latch.
- 2. 2nd Floor Middle Room MSFC1026.1 Provide and maintain an approved escape window from each sleeping room. The minimum size must be 5 square feet of glazed area with a minimum of 24 inches of openable height and 20 inches of openable width. With a finished sill height not more than 48 inches. This work may require permit(s). Call DSI at (651)- 266-9090. Refer to the Escape Windows for Residential Occupancies handout for more information.-Double-hung window has an openable area of 21 inches high by 24 inches wide and a glazed area of 5.7 square feet.

- 3. Basement Electrical Panel NEC 408.4 Circuit Directory Every electrical circuit shall be legibly identified as to its clear, evident, and specific purpose or use.
- 4. Basement Throughout UMC 2213 (f) Install proper hangers and support for the gas piping in compliance with the mechanical code.
- 5. Basement Throughout SPC 4715.1430, & 1440 Provide approved support for all plumbing piping.
- 6. Basement Water Heater SPLC 34.11 (5), 34.34 (2) Contact a licensed contractor to repair or replace the water heater. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-9090.-Water heater has corrosion in multiple areas and is leaking slightly at water connections.

Vent is not connected or secured in an approved manner.

This repair must be completed using a licensed contractor.

- 7. Basement Water Meter MSFC 605.1 -Provide a grounding jumper around the water meter.
- 8. Garage SPLC 34.19 Provide access to the inspector to all areas of the building.
- 9. SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3) Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office.
- 10. SPLC 39.02(c) Complete and sign the provided smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.
- 11. MN State Statute 299F.50 Immediately provide and maintain an approved Carbon Monoxide Alarm in a location within ten (10) feet of each sleeping area. Installation shall be in accordance with manufacturers instructions.
