- Remove improperly stored or accumulated refuse including: garbage, rubbish, discarded furniture, appliances, vehicle parts, scrap wood and metal, recycling materials, household items, building materials or rubble, tires, brush, etc., from yard areas. **SHEETS OF PLYWOOD AT REAR OF PROPERTY**
- Cut and remove tall grass, weeds and rank plant growth.
- IMMEDIATELY secure all buildings which are open to unauthorized entry, including:
- Other: **WORK CREW SENT TO PROPERTY TO REMOVE PLYWOOD AND DISCOVERED LARGE HOLE'S UNDER WOOD -HOLE NEED TO BE FILLED IN AND PLYWOOD REMOVED**

If you do not correct the nuisance or file an appeal before **May 07, 2012**, the City will correct the nuisance and charge all costs, including boarding costs, against the property as a special assessment to be collected in the same way as property taxes.

Charges: If the City corrects the nuisance, the charges will include the cost of correction, inspection, travel time, equipment, etc. The rate will be approximately \$260.00 per hour plus expenses for abatement.

You must maintain the premises in a clean condition and provide proper and adequate refuse storage at all times
