The items on the list must be corrected prior to the re-inspection date. A re-inspection will be made on April 27, 2012 at 1:00P.M..

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional re-inspection fees.

YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR NOTIFYING TENANTS IF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING LIST OF DEFICIENCIES ARE THEIR RESPONSIBILITY.

#### **DEFICIENCY LIST**

- 1. Front storm door SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) Repair and maintain the door in good condition.
- Garage SPLC 34.08 (5), 34.31 (3) Repair, replace and maintain all exterior surfaces on fences, sheds, garages and other accessory structures free from holes and deterioration. Provide and maintain exterior unprotected surfaces painted or protected from the elements.
  Comply by May 15.2012
- 3. Leading to basement SPLC 34.10 (7), 34.33 (6) Repair and maintain the floor in an approved manner.-Repair or replace the floor tile.
- 4. North side rear bedroom MSFC1026.1 Provide and maintain an approved escape window from each sleeping room. The minimum size must be 5 square feet of glazed area with a minimum of 24 inches of openable height and 20 inches of openable width. With a finished sill height not more than 48 inches. This work will require permit(s). Call DSI at (651)- 266-An Equal Opportunity Employer

9090. Refer to the Escape Windows for Residential Occupancies handout for more information.-Double hung window. 17inches openable height. Openable width is 23inches. Sill 35inches. Glazed 40 inches in height by 21inches in \_\_\_\_ width.

5. SPLC 34.09 (1) b,c, 34.32 (1) b,c - Provide and maintain all exterior walls free from holes and deterioration. All wood exterior unprotected surfaces must be painted or protected from the elements and maintained in a professional manner free from chipped or peeling paint. Comply by May 15, 2012

6. SPLC 34.09 (1) e, 34.32 (1) d - Provide and maintained the roof weather tight and free from defects.

7. SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) - Provide or repair and maintain the window screens.

8. SPLC 34.10 (6), 34.33 (5) - Exterminate and control insects, rodents or other pests. Provide documentation of extermination. Have a license exterminator do the extermination.

9. UMC 504.6 - Provide, repair or replace the dryer exhaust duct. Exhaust ducts for domestic clothes dryers shall be constructed of metal and shall have a smooth interior finish. The exhaust duct shall be a minimum nominal size of four inches (102 mm) in diameter. This work will require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-8989. And attempt was made without permit to install dryer vent.

10. SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3) - Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office.
