Dear Property Representative:

Your building was re-inspected for the Fire Certificate of Occupancy on April 19, 2012. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected immediately.

#### A re-inspection will be made on or after May 21, 2012.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

#### **DEFICIENCY LIST**

1. Interior - MSFC1026.1 - Provide and maintain an approved escape window from each sleeping room. The minimum size must be 5 square feet of glazed area with a minimum of 24 inches of openable height and 20 inches of openable width. With a finished sill height not more than 48 inches. This work may require permit(s). Call DSI at (651) - 266-9090. Refer to the Escape Windows for Residential Occupanices handout for more information.-The window on the second floor measure 19H x 20W.

You have the right to appeal these orders to the Legislative Hearing Officer.
