Dear Property Representative:

Your building was inspected on April 30, 2012 for the renewal of your Fire Certificate of Occupancy. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected prior to the re-inspection date.

A re-inspection will be made after July 2, 2012.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR NOTIFYING TENANTS IF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING LIST OF DEFICIENCIES ARE THEIR RESPONSIBILITY.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. Exterior SPLC 34.09 (1) e, 34.32 (1) d Provide and maintain the roof weather tight and free from defects. Repair soffit and fascia on West side of roofs.
- 2. Exterior SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) Provide or repair and maintain the window screens throughout the building.
- 3. Exterior MSFC1026.1 Provide and maintain an approved escape window from each sleeping room. The minimum size must be 5 square feet of glazed area with a minimum of 24 inches of openable height and 20 inches of openable width. With a finished sill height not more than 48 inches. This work may require permit(s). Call DSI at (651)-

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266-9090. Refer to the Escape Windows for Residential Occupancies handout for more information.-2nd Floor Bedroom: 23 inches high by 26 inches wide openable; 44 inches high by 24 inches wide glazed.

- 4. Interior MSFC 605.4 Discontinue use of all multi-plug adapters. High draw appliances must be plugged directly into electrical outlets.-Multi plug adapters in kitchen and basement.
- 5. Interior UMC 504.6 Provide, repair or replace the dryer exhaust duct. Exhaust ducts for domestic clothes dryers shall be constructed of metal and shall have a smooth interior finish. The exhaust duct shall be a minimum nominal size of four inches (102 mm) in diameter. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-8989.
- 6. Interior MSFC 315.2.3 Remove combustible storage from the fuel burning equipment rooms.
- 7. Interior UMC 1346.703 Provide 30 inches clearance around all mechanical equipment in basement.
- 8. SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3) Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office.
