Your building was inspected on May 4, 2012 for the renewal of your Fire Certificate of Occupancy. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected prior to the re-inspection date.

A re-inspection will be made on June 5, 2012 at 1:30 PM.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR NOTIFYING TENANTS IF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING LIST OF DEFICIENCIES ARE THEIR RESPONSIBILITY.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. **BASEMENT** SPLC 34.10 (3) 34.33(2) Provide an approved guardrail. Intermediate balustrade must not be more than 4 inches apart. Intermediate rails must be provided if the height of the platform is more than 30 inches.
- 2. **BASEMENT & GARAGE** MSFC 605.6 Provide electrical cover plates to all outlets, switches and junction boxes where missing.
- 3. **BEDROOMS -** MSFC1026.1 Provide and maintain an approved escape window from each sleeping room. The minimum size must be 5 square feet of glazed area with a minimum of 24 inches of openable height and 20 inches of openable width. With a An Equal Opportunity Employer

finished sill height not more than 48 inches. This work may require permit(s). Call DSI at (651)- 266-9090. DIMENSIONS; 25 INCHES WIDE X 23 1/2 INCHES HIGH, WITH A NET GLAZED AREA OF 25 X 43 INCHES, DOUBLE HUNG

- 4. **EXTERIOR** MSFC 605.5 Discontinue use of extension cords used in lieu of permanent wiring. HOLIDAY LIGHTING MUST BE REMOVED ON THE FRONT PORCH AND REAR DECK AREAS.
- 5. SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3) Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office.
