Dear Property Representative:

Your building was inspected on May 10, 2012 for the renewal of your Fire Certificate of Occupancy. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected prior to the re-inspection date.

A re-inspection will be made on June 15, 2012 at 10:00AM.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR NOTIFYING TENANTS IF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING LIST OF DEFICIENCIES ARE THEIR RESPONSIBILITY.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. EXTERIOR SPLC 34.08 (7) All parking spaces shall be paved with asphalt, concrete, or durable dustless surfacing. Before any existing spaces may be paved, site plan approval must be obtained as specified in the St. Paul Zoning Code. Contact DSI Zoning at 651-266-9090.
- 2. EXTERIOR SPLC 34.09 (2), 34.32(2) Repair or replace the unsafe rear stairway. There's a hole in the concrete tread and needs to be repaired in an approved manner. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-9090.

- 3. EXTERIOR SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) Provide or repair and maintain the window screen.
- 4. EXTERIOR UMC 504.6 Provide, repair or replace the dryer exhaust duct. Exhaust ducts for domestic clothes dryers shall be constructed of metal and shall have a smooth interior finish. The exhaust duct shall be a minimum nominal size of four inches (102 mm) in diameter. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-8989.- PROVIDE EXTERIOR WEATHER CAP FOR DRYER DUCT TERMIINATION AT BASEMENT WINDOW.
- 5. SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3) Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office.
- 6. SPLC 39.02(c) Complete and sign the smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.
- 7. SPLC 34.19 Provide access to the inspector to all areas of the building.
