Your building was inspected on May 16, 2012 for the renewal of your Fire Certificate of Occupancy. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected prior to the re-inspection date.

A re-inspection will be made on June 18, 2012 at 1:00PM.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR NOTIFYING TENANTS IF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING LIST OF DEFICIENCIES ARE THEIR RESPONSIBILITY.

DEFICIENCY LIST

1. Bedrooms - MSFC1026.1 - Provide and maintain an approved escape window from each sleeping room. The minimum size must be 5 square feet of glazed area with a minimum of 24 inches of openable height and 20 inches of openable width. With a finished sill height not more than 48 inches. This work will require permit(s). Call DSI at (651)-266-9090.

WINDOW DIMENSIONS; (LOWER UNIT) 25 INCHES WIDE X 20 INCHES HIGH, WITH A GLAZED AREA OF 25 X 42 DH, 19 INCHES WIDE X 21 INCHES HIGH, GLAZED AREA 19 X 44 DH (UPPER UNIT) 23 INCHES WIDE X 19 INCHES HIGH, GLAZED AREA 23 X 40 DH.

- 2. EXTERIOR SPLC 34.09 (1)*b,c, 34.32 (1) b,c Provide and maintain all exterior walls free from holes and deterioration. All wood exterior unprotected surfaces must be painted or protected from the elements and maintained in a professional manner free from chipped or peeling paint.
- 3. GARAGE SPLC 71.01 Provide address numbers on alley side of garage.
- 4. UPPER UNIT MSFC 1011.2 Remove the materials that cause an exit obstruction. Maintain a clear and unobstructed exitway. **REMOVE THE CABINET WHICH OBSTRUCTS REAR EXIT DOOR.**
- 5. UPPER UNIT MSFC 605.5 Discontinue use of extension cords used in lieu of permanent wiring.
