FIRE INSPECTION CORRECTION NOTICE

Dear Property Representative:

Your building was inspected on April 17, 2012 for the renewal of your Fire Certificate of Occupancy. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected prior to the re-inspection date. A reinspection will be made on May 22, 2012 at 1:00 PM.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR NOTIFYING TENANTS IF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING LIST OF DEFICIENCIES ARE THEIR RESPONSIBILITY.

DEFICIENCY LIST

1. Basement - MSFC1026.1 - Provide and maintain an approved escape window from each sleeping room. The minimum size must be 5 square feet of glazed area with a minimum of 24 inches of openable height and 20 inches of openable width. With a finished sill height not more than 48 inches. This work requires permit(s). Call DSI at (651)- 266-9090. Refer to the Escape Windows for Residential Occupancies handout for more information.-Egress windows were installed without the required building permit. Pull permit. Have windows inspected and permit approved.

Living room - horizontal slider window 26 w x 45 h Glazed 16 sq ft

Southeast bedroom - casement window 20.5 w x 43 h Glazed 7.5 sq ft

Northwest bedroom - horizontal slider window 27 w x 44.5 h Glazed 16 sq ft

- 2. Basement SPLC 34.13 (1) Provide and maintain all habitable areas with a ceiling height of 7 feet over 1/2 the floor area.Living room is 132 square feet and has a ceiling height of 6 feet 9.75 inches.
 Northwest room is 122 square feet and has a ceiling height of 6 feet 9.75 inches.
 Southeast room is 123 square feet and has a ceiling height of 6 feet 9.75 inches.
- 3. Exterior SPLC 34.09 (1) b,c, 34.32 (1) b,c Provide and maintain all exterior walls free from holes and deterioration. All wood exterior unprotected surfaces must be painted or protected from the elements and maintained in a professional manner free from chipped or peeling paint.-Repair holes in foundation and exterior walls in an approved manner.
- 4. Garage receptacle MSFC 605.1 Repair or replace damaged electrical fixtures. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-9090.
- 5. Garage MSFC 605.6 Provide electrical cover plates to all outlets, switches and junction boxes where missing.
- 6. Garage SPLC 34.08 (5), 34.31 (3) Repair, replace and maintain all exterior surfaces on fences, sheds, garages and other accessory structures free from holes and deterioration. Provide and maintain exterior unprotected surfaces painted or protected from the elements.
- 7. Garage SPLC 34.09 (1) e, 34.32 (1) d Provide and maintained the roof weather tight and free from defects.
- 8. House SPLC 34.09 (1) e, 34.32 (1) d Provide and maintained the roof weather tight and free from defects.
- 9. Shed Southwest corner of property SPLC 34.08 (5), 34.31 (3) Repair, replace and maintain all exterior surfaces on fences, sheds, garages and other accessory structures free from holes and deterioration. Provide and maintain exterior unprotected surfaces painted or protected from the elements.
- 10. Southwest bedroom on first floor South window SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) Repair and maintain the window sash.-Windows shall have hardware to hold them in the open position.
- 11. Throughout SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) Provide or repair and maintain the window screen.
- 12. Throughout MSFC 605.6 Provide electrical cover plates to all outlets, switches and junction boxes where missing.
- 13. SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3) Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office.
- 14. SPLC 39.02(c) Complete and sign the smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.

- 15. UMC 504.6 Provide, repair or replace the dryer exhaust duct. Exhaust ducts for domestic clothes dryers shall be constructed of metal and shall have a smooth interior finish. The exhaust duct shall be a minimum nominal size of four inches (102 mm) in diameter. This work requires a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-8989.
- 16. MN State Statute 299F.50 Immediately provide and maintain an approved Carbon Monoxide Alarm in a location within ten (10) feet of each sleeping area. Installation shall be in accordance with manufacturers instructions.

You have the right to appeal these orders to the Legislative Hearing Officer.
