Dear Property Representative:

An inspection was made of your building on May 15, 2012 in response to a referral. You are hereby notified that the following deficiency list must be corrected immediately.

A re-inspection will not be required provided a variance is granted on the bedroom egress windows by end of business day on June 15, 2012.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or revocation of the Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional re-inspection fees.

DEFICIENCY LIST

Unit 3 - Egress Windows - MSFC1026.1 - Provide and maintain an approved escape window from each 1. sleeping room. The minimum size must be 5 square feet of glazed area with a minimum of 24 inches of openable height and 20 inches of openable width. With a finished sill height not more than 48 inches. This work may require permit(s). Call DSI at (651) - 266-9090. Refer to the Escape Windows for Residential Occupancies handout for more information.

Southwest Bedroom (Double-hung)

20h x 25w - Openable 41h x 23.5w - Glazed

Note: This bedroom is not currently being used as a bedroom. Only exercise equipment in this bedroom.

Southeast Bedroom (Double-hung)

20.75h x 25w - Openable 41h x 23.5w - Glazed
