### Dear Property Representative:

Your building was inspected on May 10, 2012 for the renewal of your Fire Certificate of Occupancy. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected prior to the re-inspection date. A reinspection will be made on June 8, 2012 at 11:00 AM.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR NOTIFYING TENANTS IF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING LIST OF DEFICIENCIES ARE THEIR RESPONSIBILITY.

#### **DEFICIENCY LIST**

- 1. 1st Floor Bath MSFC 605.1- All light fixtures shall be maintained with protective globes if originally equipped.
- 2. 1st Floor Southwest bedroom SPLC 34.10 (7), 34.33 (6) Repair and maintain the walls in an approved manner.-Patch the holes and/or cracks in the walls. Paint the wall.
- 3. 1st Floor Southwest bedroom MSFC1026.1 Provide and maintain an approved escape window from each sleeping room. The minimum size must be 5 square feet of glazed area with a minimum of 24 inches of openable height and 20 inches of openable width. With a An Equal Opportunity Employer

finished sill height not more than 48 inches. This work may require permit(s). Call DSI at (651)- 266-9090. Refer to the Escape Windows for Residential Occupanices handout for more information.-Double hung window opening.

H 23 in. - W 29.5 in.

4. 2nd Floor - North and West bedrooms - MSFC1026.1 - Provide and maintain an approved escape window from each sleeping room. The minimum size must be 5 square feet of glazed area with a minimum of 24 inches of openable height and 20 inches of openable width. With a finished sill height not more than 48 inches. This work may require permit(s). Call DSI at (651)- 266-9090. Refer to the Escape Windows for Residential Occupanices handout for more information.-Double hung window opening. H 16.5 in. - W 21.5 in.

H 36 in. - W 19 in.

- 5. 2nd Floor stairwell SPLC 34.09 (2), 34.32(2) Repair or replace the damaged guardrail in an approved manner. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-9090.-Top of stairs missing guard rail.
- 6. Basement UMC 504.6 Provide, repair or replace the dryer exhaust duct. Exhaust ducts for domestic clothes dryers shall be constructed of metal and shall have a smooth interior finish. The exhaust duct shall be a minimum nominal size of four inches (102 mm) in diameter. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-8989.-REQUIRES LICENSED CONTRACTOR WITH PERMIT AND INSPECTION BY WARM AIR / VENT INSPECTOR. CALL GARY 266-9064
- 7. Basement stairs SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) Repair and maintain the door in good condition.-Exit door missing door knob.
- 8. Driveway SPLC 34.08 (5), 34.31 (3) Repair, replace and maintain all exterior surfaces on fences, sheds, garages and other accessory structures free from holes and deterioration. Provide and maintain exterior unprotected surfaces painted or protected from the elements.- Driveway needs repair / replace.
- 9. Driveway SPLC 34.08 (1), 34.31 (1) All exterior property areas shall be maintained free from any accumulation of refuse, garbage or feces.-Torn open garbage bags.
- 10. Garage SPLC 34.08 (5), 34.31 (3) Repair, replace and maintain all exterior surfaces on fences, sheds, garages and other accessory structures free from holes and deterioration. Provide and maintain exterior unprotected surfaces painted or protected from the elements.-Bottom panel of vehicle door needs repair / paint.
- 11. Living room MSFC 605.5 Discontinue use of extension cords used in lieu of permanent wiring.-Replace with power strip if needed.

- 12. SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3) Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office.
- 13. SPLC 39.02(c) Complete and sign the smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.
- 14. SPLC 45.03 (6) Cut and maintain the grass/weeds less than 8 inches tall. Saint Paul Legislative Code authorizes this inspection and collection of inspection fees. You have the right to appeal these orders to the Legislative Hearing Officer. Applications for appeals may be obtained at the Office of the City Clerk, 310 City Hall, City/County Courthouse, 15 W Kellogg Blvd, Saint Paul MN 55102 Phone: (651-266-8688) and must be filed within 10 days of the date of this order.
