Dear Property Representative:

Your building was re-inspected for the Fire Certificate of Occupancy on April 26, 2012. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected immediately. A reinspection will be made on May 25, 2012 at 1:30P.M..

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

## **DEFICIENCY LIST**

- 1. All bedrooms are on the East Side MSFC1026.1 Provide and maintain an approved escape window from each sleeping room. The minimum size must be 5 square feet of glazed area with a minimum of 24 inches of openable height and 20 inches of openable width. With a finished sill height not more than 48 inches. This work may require permit(s). Call DSI at (651)- 266-9090. Refer to the Escape Windows for Residential Occupancies handout for more information.-Openable height is 22inches. Openable width is 31inches. Glazed is 42inches in height by 30inches in width. Sill is 32inches. Double hung windows.
- 2. Front and Rear Exit doors SPLC 34.09 (3) i Provide and maintain an approved one-inch throw single cylinder deadbolt lock.
