Revocation of Fire Certificate of Occupancy and Order to Vacate

RE: 1194 MATILDA ST

Dear Property Representative:

Your building was inspected on May 23, 2012, for the renewal of the Certificate of Occupancy. Since you have failed to comply with the applicable requirements, it has become necessary to revoke the Certificate of Occupancy in accordance with Section 40.06 of the Saint Paul Legislative Code.

A re-inspection will be made on June 1, 2012 at 11:30 am or the property vacated.

The Saint Paul Legislative Code further provides that no building shall be occupied without a Certificate of Occupancy. Failure to immediately complete the following deficiency list or the building vacated may result in a criminal citation.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. Exterior SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) Repair and maintain the door in good condition.- Repair or replace the storm door.
- 2. Exterior SPLC 71.01 The address posted is not visible from street.-Provide reflective numbers or background or illuminate at night.
- 3. Interior-Basement UMC 504.6 Provide, repair or replace the dryer exhaust duct. Exhaust ducts for domestic clothes dryers shall be constructed of metal and shall have a smooth interior finish. The exhaust duct shall be a minimum nominal size of four inches (102 mm) in diameter. This work requires a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-8989.
- 4. Interior-Basement and Throughout SPLC 34.11 (5), 34.34 (2) Contact a licensed contractor to repair or replace the water heater. This work requires a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-9090. All work must be inspected and approved.-Hire a licensed plumber to repair the water heater and all basement plumbing to meet code. Permit required.

- 5. Interior-Kitchen SPLC 34.10 (7), 34.33 (6) Repair and maintain the floor in an approved manner.-Repair or replace the kitchen floor.
- 6. Interior-Throughout MSFC 1011.2 Remove the materials that cause an exit obstruction. Maintain a clear and unobstructed exitway.-Remove furniture blocking the upstairs egress window and keep all shoes off of all interior stairs.
- 7. SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3) Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office.
- 8. SPLC 39.02(c) Complete and sign the smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.

You have the right to appeal these orders to the Legislative Hearing Officer.
