The items on the list must be corrected prior to the re-inspection date. A reinspection will be made on June 28, 2012 at 3:00 pm.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR NOTIFYING TENANTS IF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING LIST OF DEFICIENCIES ARE THEIR RESPONSIBILITY.

## **DEFICIENCY LIST**

- 1. Basement Ceiling MSFC 605.6 Provide electrical cover plates to all outlets, switches and junction boxes where missing.-Install missing cover plate on open blue junction box located on basement ceiling at bottom of basement staircase.
- 2. Basement Northwest Staircase SPLC 34.10 (3), 34.33(2) Repair or replace the damaged guardrail in an approved manner.-Replace missing balustrade on staircase.
- 3. Basement Storage Room SPLC 34.10 (7), 34.33 (6) Repair and maintain the ceiling in an approved manner.-Remove or repair storage room drop ceiling and tiles.
- 4. Exterior 2nd Floor North Stairwell Window SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) Repair and maintain the window glass.-Replace broken stairwell window.

- 5. SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3) Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office.
- 6. SPLC 39.02(c) Complete and sign the smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.
