## Revocation of Fire Certificate of Occupancy and Order to Vacate

Dear Property Representative: THE LEGISLATIVE HEARING OFFICER GAVE YOU A DEADLINE OF JUNE 1, 2012 TO BE IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE ESCAPE WINDOWS. THERE ARE NOT PERMITS OBTAINED AND NO WINDOW INSTALLATION.

Your building was inspected on June 7, 2012, for the renewal of the Certificate of Occupancy. Since you have failed to comply with the applicable requirements, it has become necessary to revoke the Certificate of Occupancy in accordance with Section 40.06 of the Saint Paul Legislative Code.

The Saint Paul Legislative Code further provides that no building shall be occupied without a Certificate of Occupancy. Failure to immediately complete the following deficiency list or the building vacated may result in a criminal citation.

## **DEFICIENCY LIST**

1. All Bedrooms - MSFC1026.1 - Provide and maintain an approved escape window from each sleeping room. The minimum size must be 5 square feet of glazed area with a minimum of 24 inches of openable height and 20 inches of openable width. With a finished sill height not more than 48 inches. This work may require permit(s). Call DSI at (651)- 266-9090. Refer to the Escape Windows for Residential Occupancies handout for more information.-15inches openable height. Openable width is 23inches. Sill 41 inches. Glazed 32 inches by 20 inches in width. Double hung windows. COMPLY BY JUNE 1,2012 PER LHO
