CORRECTION NOTICE - DAYCARE INSPECTION

RE: 72 MAYWOOD PLACE

Dear Property Representative:

An inspection was made of your building on April 13, 2012 in response to a referral. You are hereby notified that the following deficiency list must be corrected immediately. A re-inspection will be made on May 9, 2012 at 1:00PM.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or revocation of the Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional re-inspection fees.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- BASEMENT JUNCTION BOXES PROVIDE COVER PLATES MSFC 605.6 Provide electrical 1. cover plates to all outlets, switches and junction boxes where missing.-Provide cover plates for two basement open junction boxes.
- BASEMENT STAIRWAY REMOVE STORAGE OR PROVIDE PROTECTION MSFC 104.9, 2. 1005.3.2.2 - Remove the storage under the stairs or provide and maintain 1 hour fire resistive construction on the storage side of the stairs.
- BEDROOM WINDOWS OPENABLE DIMENTIONS MSFC1026.1 Provide and maintain an 3. approved escape window from each sleeping room. The minimum size must be 5 square feet of glazed area with a minimum of 24 inches of openable height and 20 inches of openable width. With a finished sill height not more than 48 inches. This work may require permit(s). Call DSI at (651) - 266-9090. Refer to the Escape Windows for Residential Occupancies handout for more information.-The northeast bedroom and the southeast bedroom each have egress windows that open 20 inches high and 31 inches wide.
- CLOTHES DRYER GAS SHUTOFF VALVE UMC 2214 Install, repair, or replace listed gas 4. appliance fuel connector maximum 3 feet in length. (Kitchen range and clothes dryer maximum 6 foot length.) This work my require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-9090.-Provide a listed gas appliance shutoff valve for the basement clothes dryer.

- 5. DECK STAIRS HANDRAIL SPLC 34.09 (2) 34.32 (2) Provide an approved handrail. The top of the handrail must be between 34 and 38 inches above the treads and run the entire length of the stair.- Provide handrails for both sides of the northeast deck stairway.
- 6. DRY VENT UMC 504.6 Provide, repair or replace the dryer exhaust duct. Exhaust ducts for domestic clothes dryers shall be constructed of metal and shall have a smooth interior finish. The exhaust duct shall be a minimum nominal size of four inches (102 mm) in diameter. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-8989.-May have up to a 6 foot metal flex vent to transition to the dryer exhaust duct.
- 7. EMERGENCY PLANS MSFC 408.9, MSFC 408.10, SPLC 39.02 Provide an approved fire and emergency evacuation plan to all dwelling units.-Provide emergency all hazard plans for the daycare licensing agency.
