Information regarding the May 12, 2012 inspection:

- 1) A complete tear off and new shingle roof was contracted for prior to this inspection. The new roof was completed last week.
- 2) and 4) Pursuant to the inspection notice in 2011, a licensed contractor performed this work on the wall and informed me no guardrail was required. The work was approved upon the reinspection. The wall is solid and I would like to patch where needed and paint all but the cap which is new and is natural aggregate and attractive.
- 3) Please grant consideration to grandfather the existing window. I am 5' 11" tall and weigh 195 pounds and can exit through the window even though I am 75 years old and not very agile.
- 8) Pursuant to the inspection notice in 2011, a licensed contractor inspected the furnace and replaced the heat exchanger and deemed the furnace to be in proper working order. The work was completed less than a year ago on June 20th, 2011 and I would like to forgo a repeated furnace inspection so soon afterward.

A re-inspection will be made on July 13, 2012 at 12:45 PM.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR NOTIFYING TENANTS IF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING LIST OF DEFICIENCIES ARE THEIR RESPONSIBILITY.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. <u>Exterior SPLC 34.09 (1) e, 34.32 (1) d</u> Provide and maintain the roof weather tight and free from defects.-Repair or replace shingles on roof in an approved manner. This work must be completed by a licensed contractor and obtain applicable permits. Call DSI at (651) 266-9090.
- 2. <u>Exterior SPLC 34.08 (5), 34.31 (3)</u> Repair, replace and maintain retaining wall free from holes and deterioration. Provide and maintain exterior unprotected surfaces painted or protected from the elements.-Repair and maintain the retaining wall in an approved manner. This work must be completed by a licensed contractor and obtain applicable permits. Call DSI at (651) 266-9090.

- 3. Exterior MSFC1026.1 Provide and maintain an approved escape window from each sleeping room. The minimum size must be 5 square feet of glazed area with a minimum of 24 inches of openable height and 20 inches of openable width. With a finished sill height not more than 48 inches. This work may require permit(s). Call DSI at (651)-266-9090. Refer to the Escape Windows for Residential Occupancies handout for more information.-2nd Floor Bedroom: 19h x 21.5w, double hung.
- 4. <u>Exterior SPLC 34.09 (2) 34.32 (2)</u> Provide an approved guardrail with intermediate balustrade or rails 4 inches or less apart outside of West side door. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-9090.
- 5. <u>Interior 2nd Floor SPLC 34.10 (3), 34.33(2)</u> Repair or replace the damaged handrail in an approved manner.
- 6. <u>Interior Basement MSFC 605.6</u> Provide electrical cover plates to all outlets, switches and junction boxes where missing.-Located near dryer.
- 7. <u>Interior Basement SPLC 34.10 (3) 34.33(2)</u> Provide an approved guardrail. Intermediate ballustrade must not be more than 4 inches apart. Intermediate rails must be provided if the height of the platform is more than 30 inches.
- 8. <u>SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3)</u> Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office.
- 9. <u>SPLC 39.02(c)</u> Complete and sign the smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.
