Your building was inspected on June 11, 2012 for the renewal of your Fire Certificate of Occupancy. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected prior to the re-inspection date.

A re-inspection will be made on July 11, 2012 at 2:00 PM.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR NOTIFYING TENANTS IF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING LIST OF DEFICIENCIES ARE THEIR RESPONSIBILITY.

DEFICIENCY LIST

Exterior - Unit 1 North East Bedroom - MSFC1026.1 - Provide and maintain an approved 1. escape window from each sleeping room. The minimum size must be 5 square feet of glazed area with a minimum of 24 inches of openable height and 20 inches of openable width. With a finished sill height not more than 48 inches. This work may require permit(s). Call DSI at (651)-266-9090. Refer to the Escape Windows for Residential Occupancies handout for more information.-North East Bedroom casement window inoperable due to damaged crank.

- 2. Exterior Unit USouth East Bedroom MSFC1026.1 Provide and maintain an approved escape window from each sleeping room. The minimum size must be 5 square feet of glazed area with a minimum of 24 inches of openable height and 20 inches of openable width. With a finished sill height not more than 48 inches. This work may require permit(s). Call DSI at (651)- 266-9090. Refer to the Escape Windows for Residential Occupancies handout for more information.-South East Bedroom casement window inoperable due to damaged crank.
- 3. Exterior Unit 3- MSFC1026.1 Provide and maintain an approved escape window from each sleeping room. The minimum size must be 5 square feet of glazed area with a minimum of 24 inches of openable height and 20 inches of openable width. With a finished sill height not more than 48 inches. This work may require permit(s). Call DSI at (651)- 266-9090. Refer to the Escape Windows for Residential Occupancies handout for more information.-South Bedroom: Casement, 15 inches wide by 47 inches high openable.
- 4. <u>Interior Basement MN Stat. 299F.362</u> Immediately provide and maintain a smoke detector located in basement near furnace.
- 5. <u>Interior Stairway SPLC 34.10 (3), 34.33(2)</u> Provide an approved handrail. The top of the handrail must be between 34 and 38 inches above the treads and run the entire length of the stair.-Top of existing railing
- 6. <u>Interior Unit 1 MSFC MSFC 1003.3.1.8</u> The maximum number of locks on unit doors is two. Remove all locks in excess of two.
- 7. <u>Interior Unit 1)- MSFC 605.5.3</u> Immediately, discontinue use of frayed, deteriorated, damaged or spliced electrical cords.-South East Bedroom.
- 8. Interior Unit 1 MSFC 1011.2 Remove the materials that cause an exit obstruction.

 Maintain a clear and unobstructed exitway.-Furniture blocking exit from South East Bedroom.
- 9. <u>Interior Unit 2 SPLC 4715.0200.F.M.</u> Repair the clogged drain line in bathroom sink.
- 10. Interior Unit 2 SPLC 34.11, SBC 2902.1, SPLC 34.17, MPC 415.0220 Repair or replace and maintain the bathtub to an operational condition.-Repair or replace and maintain an approved private tub or shower. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-9090.
- 11. <u>Interior Unit 2</u> <u>SPLC 34.10 (4), 34.33 (3)</u> Recaulk seams around tub to provide a bathroom floor impervious to water.
- 12. <u>Interior Unit 2 SPLC 34.10 (7), 34.33 (6)</u> Repair or replace and maintain the South bedroom door hinges in an approved manner.

- 13. <u>interior Unit 2 MN State Statute 299F.50</u> Immediately provide and maintain an approved Carbon Monoxide Alarm in a location within ten (10) feet of the East, South East, and South West sleeping areas. Installation shall be in accordance with manufacturers instructions.
- 14. <u>Interior Unit 3</u>- SPLC 34.10 (4), 34.33 (3) Repair or replace and maintain a sealed shower wall to ensure the bathroom floor is impervious to water.
