Revocation of Fire Certificate of Occupancy and Order to Vacate Failure to comply with City Council Resolution 10.19.2011

Dear Property Representative:

Your building was inspected on June 1, 2012, for the renewal of the Certificate of Occupancy. Since you have failed to comply with the applicable requirements, it has become necessary to revoke the Certificate of Occupancy in accordance with Section 40.06 of the Saint Paul Legislative Code. An inspection will be made on July 2, 2012 after 9:30 am or the property vacated.

The Saint Paul Legislative Code further provides that no building shall be occupied without a Certificate of Occupancy. Failure to immediately complete the following deficiency list or the building vacated may result in a criminal citation.

DEFICIENCY LIST

1. EXTERIOR - SPLC 34.08 (5), 34.31 (3) - Repair, replace and maintain all exterior surfaces on fences, sheds, garages and other accessory structures free from holes and deterioration. Provide and maintain exterior unprotected surfaces painted or protected from the elements.-Fence leaning over in rear of bldg. Some boards rotted wood, peeling stain, in poor condition. Must be repaired or replaced. Retaining wall falling over causing hazardous conditions. Repair to a safe condition.

You have the right to appeal these orders to the Legislative Hearing Officer. 
