A reinspection will be made on or after July 20, 2012.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or revocation of the Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

- Interior SPLC 34.23, MSFC 110.1 This occupancy is condemned as unfit for human habitation. This 1. occupancy must not be used until re-inspected and approved by this office.-Condemned due to lack of basic facilities (electricity). Immediately restore service or vacate the building.
- SPLC 45.03 (6) Cut and maintain the grass/weeds less than 8 inches tall on South side of building. 2.
- SPLC 34.08 (1), 34.31 (1) All exterior property areas shall be maintained free from any accumulation 3. of refuse, garbage or feces.
- SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) Provide or repair and maintain the window screens throughout the building. 4.
