Your building was re-inspected for the Fire Certificate of Occupancy on May 30, 2012. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected immediately. A reinspection will be made on July 3, 2012 at 10:00a,m,

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

- 1. #1 Frank MSFC 605.5 Discontinue use of extension cords used in lieu of permanent wiring.-Various locations
- 2. #1 Frank NEC 440.13 For cord-connected equipment such as room air conditioners, household refrigerators and freezers, drinking water coolers, and beverage dispensers, a separable connector or an attachment plug and receptacle shall be permitted to serve as the disconnecting means. The appliance must plug directly into a permanent outlet.
- 3. #1 Frank NEC 410-8 (b) (1) Provide for the incandescent fixtures in closets to have a completely enclosed lamp.
- 4. #1 Frank MSFC 1011.2 Remove the materials that cause an exit obstruction. Maintain a clear and unobstructed exitway.-Remove all storage from hallways steps and landings. Shoes charcoal shovels lawn equipments and all other storage.
- 5. #1 Frank SPLC 34.10 (4), 34.33 (3) Provide a bathroom floor impervious to water. caulk the base of the toilet .

- 6. #1 Frank MSFC 315.2.5 Fueled equipment, including but not limited to motorcycles, mopeds, lawn-care equipment and portable cooking equipment, shall not be stored, operator or repaired within a building.-Remove grill from living room
- 7. #1Bush MSFC 605.4 Discontinue use of all multi-plug adapters.-Living room
- 8. #1Bush MSFC 605.5 Discontinue use of extension cords used in lieu of permanent wiring.-Various locations
- 9. #1Bush NEC 440.13 For cord-connected equipment such as room air conditioners, household refrigerators and freezers, drinking water coolers, and beverage dispensers, a separable connector or an attachment plug and receptacle shall be permitted to serve as the disconnecting means. The appliance must plug directly into a permanent outlet.
- 10. #1Bush MSFC 1011.2 Remove the materials that cause an exit obstruction. Maintain a clear and unobstructed exitway.-Remove shoe rack tools from the front way.
- 11. #1Bush SPLC 34.10 (7), 34.33 (6) Repair and maintain the walls in an approved manner. Treat mold on walls behind toilet.-Repair or replace the damaged or deteriorated wall coverings.
- 12. #2 Bush NEC 410-8 (b) (1) Provide for the incandescent fixtures in closets to have a completely enclosed lamp.
- 13. #2 Bush MSFC 703 Front and rear etry doors.-Repair and maintain the door closer.
- 14. #2Frank MSFC 1011.2 Remove the materials that cause an exit obstruction. Maintain a clear and unobstructed exitway.-Remove all storage from all landings.
- 15. Basement MSFC 703 Provide and maintain fire rated floor and/or ceiling construction with approved materials and methods. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-9090. The minimum rating must be: 1 HOUR
- 16. SPLC 34.09 (1) b,c, 34.32 (1) b,c Provide and maintain all exterior walls free from holes and deterioration. All wood exterior unprotected surfaces must be painted or protected from the elements and maintained in a professional manner free from chipped or peeling paint.
- SPLC 34.08 (7) All parking spaces shall be paved with asphalt, concrete, or durable dustless surfacing. Before any existing spaces may be paved, site plan approval must be obtained as specified in the St. Paul Zoning Code. Contact DSI Zoning at 651-266-9090.-The ground is covered with carpet.
