NOTICE OF CONDEMNATION UNFIT FOR HUMAN HABITATION ORDER TO VACATE

Dear Property Representative:

Your building was inspected on July 18, 2012.

The building was found to be unsafe, unfit for human habitation, a public nuisance, a hazard to the public welfare or otherwise dangerous to human life. A Condemnation Placard has been posted on the building.

The following deficiency list must be completed or the building vacated by the re-inspection date.

A re-inspection will be made on July 27, 2012.

CONDEMNATION OF THE BUILDING REVOKES THE CERTIFICATE OF OCCUPANCY.

Failure to complete the corrections may result in a criminal citation. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. BUILDING SPLC 34.23, MSFC 110.1 This occupancy is condemned as unsafe or dangerous. This occupancy must not be used until re-inspected and approved by this office.
- 2. KITCHEN SUB FLOOR SPLC 34.10 (7), 34.33 (6) Repair and maintain the floor in an approved manner.

3. SIDE DOOR - MSFC 1010.1, 1003.3.1.8 - Post a sign stating 'THIS DOOR MUST REMAIN UNLOCKED WHEN BUILDING IS OCCUPIED' at main exits with interior key locks. The minimum height of the letter must be 1 inch high with a contrasting background.-Provide a sign on the inside of the door facing inward or change the lock to a thumb lock.

You have the right to appeal these orders to the Legislative Hearing Officer. 
