Your building was re-inspected for the Fire Certificate of Occupancy on July 9, 2012. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected immediately.

A reinspection will be made on August 9, 2012 at 1:00PM.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. LOWER UNIT MSFC 1011.2 Remove the materials that cause an exit obstruction. Maintain a clear and unobstructed exitway. THE WIRE MESH GATE OVER THE WINDOW OF THE SPECIAL NEEDS CHILD'S ROOM REQUIRED EGRESS WINDOW MUST BE REMOVED. (OCCUPANT / OWNER IS ENCOURAGED BASED ON THE ISSUES OF THIS CHILD TO SEEK AN APPEAL OF THIS ORDER.)
- 2. SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3) Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office.

You have the right to appeal these orders to the Legislative Hearing Officer.
