Dear Property Representative:

Your building was inspected on June 18, 2012 for the renewal of your Fire Certificate of Occupancy. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected prior to the re-inspection date.

Per your request, the re-inspection will be made on August 3, 2012 at 1:30 PM.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR NOTIFYING TENANTS IF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING LIST OF DEFICIENCIES ARE THEIR RESPONSIBILITY.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. <u>Exterior MSFC 605.6</u> Provide electrical cover plate to main service meter box.
- 2. Exterior SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) Repair and maintain the entry door frame.
- 3. <u>Interior Unit 1 MSFC 901.6</u> Provide required annual maintenance of the fire extinguishers by a qualified person and tag the fire extinguishers with the date of service.

- 4. <u>Interior Unit 1 MSFC 605.1</u>- All light fixtures shall be maintained with protective globes if originally equipped. -*Provide globe in Unit 1 North East bedroom and main entrance fover.*
- 5. <u>Interior Unit 1 SPLC 34.10 (7), 34.33 (6)</u> Repair and maintain the kitchen cabinets in an approved manner.
- 6. <u>Interior Unit 1 MSFC1026.1</u> Provide and maintain an approved escape window from each sleeping room. The minimum size must be 5 square feet of glazed area with a minimum of 24 inches of openable height and 20 inches of openable width. With a finished sill height not more than 48 inches. This work may require permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-9090. Refer to the Escape Windows for Residential Occupancies handout for more information.
 - -North West Bedroom: Window meets openable dimension requirements but discharges into enclosed porch, not into public way; window exit access also blocked by furniture.
- 7. <u>Interior Unit 1 MN Stat. 299F.362</u> Immediately provide and maintain a smoke detector located outside each sleeping area.
- 8. <u>Interior SPLC 34.10 (4), 34.33 (3)</u> Provide a bathroom floor impervious to water. -*Recaulk bathtub seams in Units 1 and 2.*
- 9. <u>SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3)</u> Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office.
