As you know, the Heritage Preservation Commission (HPC) considered at its June 28, 2012 meeting the Order to Abate for the property listed above. The HPC considered the demolition or rehabilitation of 212 Maple Street in the context of the adopted criteria for the Dayton's Bluff Historic District. On a vote of 4-2 with one abstention, the HPC recommended that demolition, if ordered by the City Council, would not have an adverse impact on the character and integrity of the Historic District. This decision was based on the staff recommendation and discussion at the public hearing.
