Dear Property Representative:

Your building was inspected on August 8, 2012 for the renewal of your Fire Certificate of Occupancy. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected prior to the re-inspection date.

A re-inspection will be made on September 11, 2012 at 1:30pm.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR NOTIFYING TENANTS IF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING LIST OF DEFICIENCIES ARE THEIR RESPONSIBILITY.

DEFICIENCY LIST

1. Electrical Permit - MSFC 105.1.1 - Permits are required for the new installation of electric circuits.-There is an open electrical permit for the electrical circuit work done by NEI Electric Company. Contact electrical inspector, Dave Blank 651-266-9035, for final inspection.

- 2. Exterior Parking Space SPLC 34.08 (7) All parking spaces shall be paved with asphalt, concrete, or durable dustless surfacing. Before any existing spaces may be paved, site plan approval must be obtained as specified in the St. Paul Zoning Code. Contact DSI Zoning at 651-266-9090.-The parking space in the rear of the property consists of gravel/class 5. This is not an approved parking surface. Provide an approved parking surface.
- 3. Exterior Rear Yard SPLC 34.09 (2) 34.32 (2) Provide an approved guardrail with intermediate balustrades or rails 4 inches or less apart. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-9090.-The retaining wall and wooden stairway in the rear yard is 39 inches in height. Provide the required guardrail on the stairway and retaining wall.
- 4. Exterior Stairway SPLC 34.09 (2) 34.32 (2) Provide an approved handrail. The top of the handrail must be between 34 and 38 inches above the treads and run the entire length of the stair.
- 5. Main Floor Bedroom MSFC 605.1 Repair or replace damaged electrical fixtures. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-9090.-Replace the damaged electrical outlet in the main floor bedroom.
- 6. Main Floor Bedroom and Laundry Room SPLC 34.12 (2), 34.35 (1) Repair and maintain all required and supplied equipment in an operative and safe condition.-Replace the missing hard-wired smoke detector in the main floor laundry room. Replace the missing battery cover on the smoke detector in the main floor bedroom.
- 7. Main Floor and Upper Floor SPLC 34.12 (2), 34.35 (1) Repair and maintain all required and supplied equipment in an operative and safe condition.-Repair/replace the inoperable light fixtures/switches throughout the property. Replace all burnt out light bulbs. Maintain all light fixtures in an operable condition.
- 8. Upper Floor Bedroom MSFC 605.5 Discontinue use of extension cords used in lieu of permanent wiring.
- Upper Floor Bedroom SPLC 34.13 (1) Provide and maintain all habitable areas with a ceiling height of 7 feet over 1/2 the floor area.

Upper Floor Bedroom

Maximum Ceiling Height = 80 inches or 6 feet, 8 inches.

Total Area = 13 feet x 13 feet = 169 sf

Area Above 5 Feet = 10 feet x 13 feet = 130 sf

Area of Ceiling at 80 inches = 4 feet x 9 feet + 4 feet x 7 feet = 64 sf

10. SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3) - Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office.

11. SPLC 39.02(c) - Complete and sign the smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.

You have the right to appeal these orders to the Legislative Hearing Officer.
