1. SKYWAY 35 - SPLC 140.10.2 - All elements of the skyway pedestrian system shall be maintained at a seasonally adjusted comfortable temperature level of seventy (70) degrees Fahrenheit, plus or minus eight (8) degrees Fahrenheit.
