Your building was inspected on September 10, 2012, for the renewal of the Certificate of Occupancy. Since you have failed to comply with the applicable requirements, it has become necessary to revoke the Certificate of Occupancy in accordance with Section 40.06 of the Saint Paul Legislative Code.

A reinspection will be made on October 12, 2012 at 1:30 PM or the property vacated.

The Saint Paul Legislative Code further provides that no building shall be occupied without a Certificate of Occupancy. Failure to immediately complete the following deficiency list or the building vacated may result in a criminal citation.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. Exterior Rear SPLC 34.09 (2), 34.32(2) Repair or replace the unsafe stairways, porch, decks or railings in an approved manner. This work **will** require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-9090. The exterior rear stairwell and second floor deck is condemned and cannot be used or occupied.
- 2. Exterior SPLC 34.08 (5), 34.31 (3) Repair, replace and maintain all exterior surfaces on fences, sheds, garages and other accessory structures free from holes and deterioration.
 - -Repair damaged retaining wall in an approved manner.
- 3. Interior & Exterior SPLC 34.09 (1) a, 34.32 (1) a Provide and maintain foundation elements to adequately support this building at all points.
 - -Repair and tuck point damaged foundation in an approved manner.

You have the right to appeal these orders to the Legislative Hearing Officer.
