NOTICE OF INTENT TO DENY LICENSE

Dear Mr. Martinez:

The Department of Safety and Inspections will recommend denial of the Taxicab Driver (Provisional) license application submitted by Anastacio A Martinez for the City of Saint Paul. The basis for the recommendation is based on the following information:

On July 9, 2012, you submitted an application for a Taxi Driver (Provisional) license. The Department of Safety and Inspections (DSI) placed an Administrative Hold on your license application until they received a copy of your Minnesota Driver's license as required by Saint Paul Legislative Code § 376.16 (e) (1) which states the following prerequisite to a license: "Possess a valid Minnesota or Wisconsin driver's license."

The Department of Safety and Inspections has made several attempts to reach you regarding this issue. As of today's date, they have not received a copy of your Minnesota Driver's license.

At this time, you have three options on how to proceed:

1. You can submit a copy of your Minnesota Driver's licenses. If this is your choice, you should send the information directly to the Department of Safety and Inspections, at 375 Jackson Street, Ste. 220, St. Paul, Minnesota 55101-1806 no later than **Thursday, October 25, 2012**. Information should be directed to the attention of Christine Rozek. A self-addressed envelope is enclosed for your convenience. Submission of the requested information will be considered to be a waiver of the hearing to which you are entitled.
2. If you wish to admit the facts but you contest the penalty, you may have a public hearing before the Saint Paul City Council. You will need to send me a letter with a statement admitting to the facts and requesting a public hearing. I will need to receive your letter no later than **Thursday, October 25, 2012**. The matter will then be scheduled before the City Council for a public hearing to determine whether to deny your Taxicab Driver (Provisional) license. You will have an opportunity to appear before the Council and make a statement on your own behalf.

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3. You may withdraw your license application. Send a written statement to that effect to the Department of Safety and Inspections (DSI), 375 Jackson Street, Ste. 220, St. Paul, Minnesota 55101-1806 no later than **Thursday, October 25, 2012**. Information should be directed to the attention of Christine Rozek. Any request for a refund of the license application fee must also be made in writing to the Department of Safety and Inspections.

If you have not contacted me by Thursday, October 25, 2012, I will assume that you do not contest the denial of your Taxicab Driver (Provisional) license. In that case, the matter will be placed on the City Council Consent Agenda for approval of the recommended penalty.
