Your building was re-inspected for the Fire Certificate of Occupancy on November 5, 2012. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected immediately.

A reinspection will be made on December 12, 2012 at 12:30PM.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. SPLC 39.02(c) Complete and sign the smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.
- 2. MN Stat. 299F.362 Immediately provide and maintain a smoke detector located outside each sleeping area.(INSURE THAT ALL RENTAL UNITS HAVE A WORKING SMOKE ALARM WITHIN 10FT OF SLEEPING ROOMS.)
- 3. MN State Statute 299F.50 Immediately provide and maintain an approved Carbon Monoxide Alarm in a location within ten (10) feet of each sleeping area. Installation shall be in accordance with manufacturers instructions.(ALL RENTAL UNITS REQUIRE A WORKING CO DETECTOR AS REQUIRED ABOVE.)
- 4. MSFC 1027.16.5 Materials and strength; Fire escapes shall be kept clear and unobstructed at all times and shall be maintained in good working order.
