The City of Saint Paul, Department of Safety and Inspections has inspected the above referenced property on October 30, 2012 and has determined that the following deficiencies exist in violation of the Saint Paul Legislative Code¹ (see footnote 1, below).

1. All vehicles must be correctly licensed, operable, secure from unauthorized entry, and parked on an improved surface. Correct violations; store in a garage or remove. Blue Ford truck license # 301 762 in rear yard.

The Enforcement Officer will reinspect these premises on or after November 05, 2012, by which date the violations noted must be corrected.
