Dear Mr. Hass:

This is to confirm that our office has received your application for a variance from the city's noise ordinance and that it is being processed.

The Department of Safety and Inspections has recommended that a variance be issued to operate boilers and generators for a sewer lining project on Marshall Avenue between Cretin and Moore for 24 hours a day for an unspecified 20 day time period from February 25, 2013 to April 12, 2013. The recommendation is to use best practical methods to control the sound level.

A public hearing on your request for a variance has been scheduled for February 6, 2013, 5:30 p.m., Third Floor, City Council Chambers, at the Saint Paul City Hall/Ramsey County Courthouse, 15 Kellogg Boulevard W., Saint Paul, Minnesota.

You may wish to be present at this hearing to answer any questions that the City Council might have. After the public hearing, the Council may grant, deny, or modify the variance request.
