## **Revocation of Fire Certificate of Occupancy and Order to Vacate**

Dear Property Representative:

Your building was inspected on January 3, 2013, for the renewal of the Certificate of Occupancy. Since you have failed to comply with the applicable requirements, it has become necessary to revoke the Certificate of Occupancy in accordance with Section 40.06 of the Saint Paul Legislative Code. An inspection will be made on January 14, 2013 after 9:30 am and the property vacated.

The Saint Paul Legislative Code further provides that no building shall be occupied without a Certificate of Occupancy. Failure to immediately complete the following deficiency list or the building vacated may result in a criminal citation.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. Exterior Trash Bin SPLC 34.11 (7), 34.34 (4) Provide additional approved containers or additional pick-ups to meet tenant trash demands.
- 2. Interior Exterminator SPLC 34.10 (6), 34.33 (5) Exterminate and control insects, rodents or other pests. Provide documentation of extermination.-There are signs of mice activity in the building. Contact a licensed exterminator to treat the entire building.
- 3. UNIT 01 Multiple Rooms SPLC 34.10 (7), 34.33 (6) Repair and maintain the walls in an approved manner.-Patch the holes and/or cracks in the walls in east, north bedrooms and living room.
- 4. UNIT 02 East Hallway MSFC 1011.2 Remove the materials that cause an exit obstruction. Maintain a clear and unobstructed exitway.-Cable cord in hallway causing tripping hazard.

- 5. UNIT 02/BLDG 953 East Entry/Exit Door Throughout MSFC 703 Provide, repair or replace the fire rated door and assembly. The minimum rating must be:-Repair and maintain the door closers and door latches throughout property. Multiple door
- 6. UNIT 03 RED TAGGED FURNACE SPLC 34.23, MSFC 110.1 This occupancy is condemned as unfit for human habitation. This occupancy must not be used until reinspected and approved by this office.-CO 11 PPM, OVEN NEED REPAIR OR REPLACEMENT PER XCEL ENERGY 11.27.2012.
- 7. UNIT 03 Window SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) Repair and maintain the window in good condition. A new window was installed without permit. This work requires a permit. Contact DSI at 651-266-8989 and obtain approval under permit.
- 8. UNITS 01 and 03 Electrical Service Throughout SPLC 34.14 (2), 34.34 (5) Provide an approved electrical service adequate to meet the buildings needs. This work may require a permit(s), call DSI at (651) 266-9090.-Kitchen wall outlets not working during inspection. Outlets keep shorting out. No heat due to shut off. Restore heating services in unit immediately.
- 9. SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3) Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit an approved completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office.
- 10. SPLC 39.02(c) Complete and sign the smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.
