An inspection was made of your building on November 6, 2012 in response to a referral. You are hereby notified that the following deficiency list must be corrected immediately. A re-inspection will be made on December 4, 2012 at 10:00AM.

## **DEFICIENCY LIST**

- ANNUAL FURNACE MAINTENANCE PROVIDE DOCUMENTATION SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 1. (3) - Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office.
- BASEMENT ORDERLY STORAGE MSFC 315.2 Provide and maintain orderly storage of 2. materials.-Provide orderly storage or remove various combustible storage in several basement rooms and near the basement stairway.
- 3. BASEMENT - PROVIDE WORKING SMOKE DETECTOR - MN Stat. 299F.362 - Immediately provide and maintain a smoke detector located outside each sleeping area.-Provide a working smoke detector for the basement level.
- DAYCARE SLEEPING ROOMS WINDOWS OPENABLE DIMENSIONS MSFC1026.1 Provide 4. and maintain an approved escape window from each sleeping room. The minimum size must be 5 square feet of glazed area with a minimum of 24 inches of openable height and 20 inches of openable width. With a finished sill height not more than 48 inches. This work may require permit(s), Call DSI at (651) - 266-9090. Refer to the Escape Windows for Residential Occupancies handout for more information.-Daycare sleeping bedrooms have the following openable dimensions. Southeast bedroom two windows with openable dimensions of 16 inches high by 36.5 inches wide. Southwest bedroom has two windows with openable dimensions of 16 inches high by 36.5 inches wide.
- EMERGENCY PLANS PROVIDE DOCUMENTATION MSFC 404.2 Provide an approved fire 5. and emergency evacuation plan.

- 6. KITCHEN PROVIDE FIRE EXTINGUISHER MSFC 906.1, MN Stat. 299F.361-Provide minimum 2A10BC fire extinguisher in the kitchen. It must be permanently mounted between 3 and 5 feet high in readily visible and easily accessible location.
- 7. KITCHEN AND BASEMENT REMOVE MULTI PLUG ADAPTERS MSFC 605.4 Discontinue use of all multi-plug adapters.-Remove multi plug adapters in the kitchen and basement near the refrigerator.
- 8. OUTLET COVERS PROVIDE FOR UNUSED OUTLETS Provide outlet covers on all unused accessible outlets.
