Revocation of Fire Certificate of Occupancy and Order to Vacate

Dear Property Representative:

Your building was determined to be a registered vacant building on February 7, 2013. Since certificates are for the occupancy of buildings, it has become necessary to revoke the Certificate of Occupancy.

Saint Paul Legislative Code provides that no building shall be occupied without a Certificate of Occupancy. In order to re-occupy the building, the following deficiencies (if applicable) must be corrected and a complete Certificate of Occupancy inspection will be required.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. Exterior SPLC 34.09 (1) b,c, 34.32 (1) b,c Provide and maintain all exterior walls free from holes and deterioration. All wood exterior unprotected surfaces must be painted or protected from the elements and maintained in a professional manner free from chipped or peeling paint.
- 2. Exterior SPLC 34.08 (7) All parking spaces shall be paved with asphalt, concrete, or durable dustless surfacing. Before any existing spaces may be paved, site plan approval must be obtained as specified in the St. Paul Zoning Code. Contact DSI Zoning at 651-266-9090.
- 3. Exterior SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) Repair and maintain the doors in good condition.
- 4. Exterior SPLC 163.03, 163.01 (2), (3) Currently license (tabs) all vehicles on the property and return the vehicles to an operative mechanical condition or remove vehicles from the property.

- 5. Exterior Remove the accumulation of snow or ice from the public and private sidewalk abutting this property.
- 6. Exterior-Throughout SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) Repair and maintain the window frames throughout.
- 7. Exterior-Throughout SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) Provide or repair and maintain the window screens.
- 8. Interior Throughout SPLC 34.19 Provide access to the inspector to all areas of the building.
- 9. Interior SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) Repair and maintain the window locks.
- 10. Interior-Throughout SPLC 34.19 Provide access to the inspector to all areas of the building.
- 11. SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3) Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office.
- 12. SPLC 39.02(c) Complete and sign the provided smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.
