> Jonathan North, Office of Financial Services (OFS), gave a staff report on the results of that morning's bond sale. He said the goal of the sale was to refund existing 2003 and 2005 bonds for straight interest rate savings. He said the City's high credit ratings had been affirmed by both ratings agencies, and twelve bids had been received. He reviewed the winning bids and said the result would be \$170,00 per year in savings. He commended SPRWS staff and Board of Commissioners, and thanked Springsted, Kennedy and Graven, and OFS staff.
