#### Dear Property Representative:

Your building was inspected on April 5, 2013 for the renewal of your Fire Certificate of Occupancy. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected prior to the re-inspection date. A reinspection will be made on May 6, 2013 at 1:30PM.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR NOTIFYING TENANTS IF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING LIST OF DEFICIENCIES ARE THEIR RESPONSIBILITY.

#### **DEFICIENCY LIST**

- 1. SPLC 39.02(c) Complete and sign the smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.
- 2. SPLC 71.01 Provide address numbers on rear of building.
- 3. SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.33 (3) -Provide or repair and maintain the window screen.

- 4. SPLC 34.09 (1) b,c, 34.33 (1) b, c Provide and maintain all exterior walls free from holes and deterioration. All wood exterior unprotected surfaces must be painted or protected from the elements and maintained in a professional manner free from chipped or peeling paint. (REPAIR DAMAGED WOOD ON FRONT PORCH, COMPLETE THE REPAIR OF SIDING AND SOFFIT WORK. ALL SURFACES SHALL BE PAINTED IN A PROFESSIONAL MANNER.)
- 5. SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) Repair and maintain the door latch.(EXTERIOR ENTRANCE DOORS SHALL HAVE AN OPERABLE HANDLES AND DOOR LATCH.)
- 6. SPLC 34.10 (7), 34.34 (6) Repair and maintain the floor in an approved manner.(DAMAGED FLOOR COVERINGS AND SURFACES MUST BE REPAIRED IN AN APPROVE MANNER.)
- 7. SPLC 34.10 (7), 34.34 (6) Repair and maintain the ceiling in an approved manner. (REPAIR AND PAINT ALL DAMAGED CEILING SURFACES IN AN APPROVED MANNER. (THROUGH OUT)
- 8. SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) Repair and maintain the window frame. (FINISH CASING AROUND ALL WINDOWS THAT HAVE HAD TRIM REMOVED.)
- 9. Ext. Door SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.33 (3) Repair and maintain the door in good condition.(
  ALL DOORS SHALL HAVE OPERABLE HARDWARE AND BE FINISHED OR
  PAINTED IN AN APPROVED MANNER.)
- 10. SPLC 34.10 (7), 34.33 (6) Repair and maintain the cabinets in an approved manner. (KITCHEN CABINETRY SHALL HAVE DOORS WHERE REQUIRED OR ONCE WERE PRESENT.)
- 11. SPLC 34.10 (4), 34.33 (3) Provide a bathroom floor impervious to water.
- 12. SPLC 34.10 (3), 34.33(2) Repair or replace the unsafe stairway in an approved manner. (BASEMENT STAIRWAY NEEDS REPLACED)
- 13. SPLC 34.10 (3) 34.33(2) Provide an approved guardrail. Intermediate balustrade must not be more than 4 inches apart. Intermediate rails must be provided if the height of the platform is more than 30 inches.
- 14. SPLC 34.10 (1) Abate and maintain the basement reasonably free from dampness and free of mold and mildew.
- 15. SPLC 34.09 (1) a, 34.32 (1) a Provide and maintain foundation elements to adequately support this building at all points. (REPAIR DAMAGED FOUNDATION WALLS)
- 16. MSFC 907.2.10.1 Require Smoke Alarms; (INSTALL AND MAINTAIN SMOKE ALARMS ON EVERY LEVEL OF THE HOME.)
- 17. MN State Statute 299F.50 Immediately provide and maintain an approved Carbon Monoxide Alarm in a location within ten (10) feet of each sleeping area. Installation shall be in accordance with manufacturers instructions.

18. SPLC 34.09 (2) 34.32 (2) - Provide an approved handrail. The top of the handrail must be between 34 and 38 inches above the treads and run the entire length of the stair.

(INSTALL HANDRAIL AT FRONT ENTRANCE STAIRS.)

ALL TRADES, PLUMBING, ELECTRICAL, HEATING, BUILDING WORK MUST BE COMPLETED UNDER PERMIT. ALL WORK MUST BE COMPLETED AND FINALED BEFORE C OF O IS COMPLETED.

You have the right to appeal these orders to the Legislative Hearing Officer.
