## Revocation of Fire Certificate of Occupancy and Order to Vacate

Dear Property Representative:

Your building was inspected on April 1, 2013, for the renewal of the Certificate of Occupancy. Since you have failed to comply with the applicable requirements, it has become necessary to revoke the Certificate of Occupancy in accordance with Section 40.06 of the Saint Paul Legislative Code.

A reinspection will be made on April 31, 2013 at 2:00PM or the property vacated.

The Saint Paul Legislative Code further provides that no building shall be occupied without a Certificate of Occupancy. Failure to immediately complete the following deficiency list or the building vacated may result in a criminal citation.

## **DEFICIENCY LIST**

- 1. SPLC 39.02(c) Complete and sign the smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.
- 2. MFGC 409.5 Provide an approved gas shut off valve within 6 feet of the appliance in accordance with the mechanical code. This work will require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-8989.(INSTALL GAS VALVE AS REQUIRED ON THE DRYER IN THE BASEMENT OF 953.)
- 3. SPLC 34.10 (7), 34.33 (6) Repair and maintain the ceiling in an approved manner.(REPAIR WATER DAMAGED CEILINGS IN THE KITCHEN OF 953)
- 4. MSFC 907.10.1.2- Immediately provide and maintain a smoke detector in each story within a dwelling unit, including basements. (INSTALL SMOKE ALARMS ON MAIN LEVEL AND BASEMENT OF 951)
