### NOTICE OF CONDEMNATION UNFIT FOR HUMAN HABITATION ORDER TO VACATE

152 UNIVERSITY AVE W

Dear Property Representative:

Your building was inspected on April 8, 2013.

The building was found to be unsafe, unfit for human habitation, a public nuisance, a hazard to the public welfare or otherwise dangerous to human life. A Condemnation Placard has been posted on the building.

The following deficiency list must be completed or the building vacated by the re-inspection date.

A reinspection will be made on or after April 9, 2013.

#### CONDEMNATION OF THE BUILDING REVOKES THE CERTIFICATE OF OCCUPANCY.

Failure to complete the corrections may result in a criminal citation. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy.

#### **DEFICIENCY LIST**

1. BUILDING - SPLC 34.23, MSFC 110.1 - This occupancy is condemned as unsafe or dangerous. This occupancy must not be used until re-inspected and approved by this office.

#### Building is condemned as unsafe due to the following conditions;

- -Rear staircase is structurally unsound.
- -Front and rear parapets are severely deteriorated creating a dangerous condition.
- -The sidewalk in the front of the building was closed off.

-The required second exit for the business cannot be used due to the exit being in direct line with the damaged parapet.

- 2. EXTERIOR PARAPETS SPLC 34.09 (1) b,c, 34.33 (1) b, c Provide and maintain all exterior walls free from holes and deterioration. All wood exterior unprotected surfaces must be painted or protected from the elements and maintained in a professional manner free from chipped or peeling paint. -Front and rear parapets have loose bricks and deteriorated mortar. Bricks are ready to fall onto the pedestrian walkways, tracks and street below.
- 3. EXTERIOR REAR STAIRS SPLC 34.09 (2), 34.32(2) Repair or replace the unsafe stairways, porch, decks or railings in an approved manner. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-9090. -Rear stairs have rotted wood, nails popping, and damaged structural members.
- 4. EXTERIOR ROOF SPLC 34.09 (1) e, 34.32 (1) d Provide and maintained the roof weather tight and free from defects. -Rubber membrane of roof is cracked and damaged. -Roof is very spongy.
- 5. EXTERIOR SPLC 163.03, 163.01 (2), (3) Currently license (tabs) all vehicles on the property and return the vehicles to an operative mechanical condition or remove vehicles from the property.
- 6. INTERIOR SPLC 34.19 Provide access to the inspector to all areas of the building.
- 7. SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3) Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office.
- 8. SPLC 39.02(c) Complete and sign the smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.

You have the right to appeal these orders to the Legislative Hearing Officer.
