This is to inform you of a request for a variance from the sound level limitations as indicated in the St. Paul Noise Ordinance (Chapter 293 of the St. Paul Legislative Code).

Description of Variance:

<u>Noise Source</u>: The Metropolitan Council has requested a sound level variance allow Central Corridor Light Rail construction between 10:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m. Monday through Friday from June 5, 2013 to December 5, 2013. The majority of the work is expected to be completed during the months of June and July. The Department of Safety and Inspections will be recommending that the variance be granted through August 30, 2013, instead of the requested December 5, 2013. The variance will be restricted to work on the installation of the overhead catenary. No jack hammering saw cutting, and similarly loud activities will be permitted during these overnight hours.

Location: University Avenue from Emerald Street, along University Avenue West, Robert Street, 12th Street East, Cedar Street and 4th Street East ending at Broadway Street.
