This is to confirm that our office has received your application for a variance from the city's noise ordinance that it is being processed.

Metropolitan Council has requested a variance be issued to allow Central Corridor Light Rail construction between 10:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m. Monday through Friday from June 5, 2013 to December 5, 2013. The majority of the work is expected to be completed during the months of June and July. The Department of Safety and Inspections will be recommending that the variance be granted through August 30, 2013, instead of the requested December 5, 2013. The variance will be restricted to work on the installation of the overhead catenary. No jack hammering saw cutting, and similarly loud activities will be permitted during these overnight hours.

Location: University Avenue from Emerald Street, along University Avenue West, Robert Street, 12th Street East, Cedar Street and 4th Street East ending at Broadway Street.

A public hearing on your request for a variance has been scheduled for **June 5, 2013, 5:30 p.m.**, Third Floor, City Council Chambers, at the Saint Paul City Hall/Ramsey County Courthouse, 15 Kellogg Boulevard W., Saint Paul, Minnesota.
