NOTICE OF CONDEMNATION UNFIT FOR HUMAN HABITATION ORDER TO VACATE

RE: 1093 EUCLID ST

Dear Property Representative:

Your building was inspected on May 9, 2013.

The building was found to be unsafe, unfit for human habitation, a public nuisance, and a hazard to the public welfare or otherwise dangerous to human life. A Condemnation Placard has been posted on the building.

The following deficiency list must be completed or the building vacated by the re-inspection date. A reinspection will be made on May 10, 2013 at 10:00 AM.

CONDEMNATION OF THE BUILDING REVOKES THE CERTIFICATE OF OCCUPANCY.

Failure to complete the corrections may result in a criminal citation. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. SPLC 34.23, MSFC 110.1 This occupancy is condemned as unsafe or dangerous. This occupancy must not be used until re-inspected and approved by this office.

 -The North foundation wall has failed. After consultation with the city engineer, it has been determined that the building is no longer safe to occupy and must be vacated by 5/10/13 at 10:00 AM.
- 2. Basement MSFC 315.2 Provide and maintain orderly storage of materials.-Remove excessive storage and provide an orderly storage of all materials.

- 3. Basement SPLC 34.09 (1) a, 34.32 (1) a Provide and maintain foundation elements to adequately support this building at all points. The North foundation wall has failed.
 -Immediately contact a licensed structural engineer to evaluate the damaged foundation and provide an assessment and plans for repair of the damage to this office.
 This work will require a permit. Contact DSI at 651-266-8989.
- 4. Basement SPLC 34.10 (2), 34.33 Repair and maintain the damaged structural members. This repair will require a building permit; call DSI at (651) 266-9090.
- 5. SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3) Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit an approved completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office.

You have the right to appeal these orders to the Legislative Hearing Officer.
